Describe the features of the graduate program

This graduate program consists of business core, real estate core and concentration courses. Students can expect to complete a minimum of 12 courses and a maximum of up to 21 courses depending on previous academic background. Concentration areas include:

- Real Estate Asset and Property Management
- Residential Real Estate Sales, Marketing and Management
- Real Estate Appraisal and Valuation Services
- Commercial Real Estate, Investment and Analysis
- Real Estate Association Management

When are courses available?

Every eight weeks. You may apply to the graduate program at any time.

How do we deliver our courses?

Online with courses offered every eight weeks, six times a year.

What is the cost of tuition?

REALTOR® Members: \$633.33 per credit hour (\$1,900 per course)

Active-Duty Military: \$499.33 per credit hour (\$1,498 per course)

Non-Members: \$883.33 per credit hour (\$2,650 per course)

Our program costs are substantially less than the average graduate real estate program in the United States. This savings come with the most practical and applied curriculum, focused on real estate.

Can I take a course or courses even if I don't want to pursue the graduate degree?

Yes. We offer a *non-degree seeking student* category. Students are able to take the same courses offered to degree seeking students without being enrolled in the degree program. These students can take a maximum of four eight week sessions (12 credits).

Are scholarships available?

Yes. Partial scholarships based on merit are awarded through the scholarship program.

Is there a library for students?

Yes. Our library is the largest real estate library in the world with a collection of nearly 12,000 books, reports, CDs, DVDs, videos and audiotapes covering residential and commercial real estate, sales and marketing, property management, appraisal, construction, land use and planning, association management and technology. It has 7,300 business, academic and general interest journals and a collection of 4,500 digital books, audio books and videos.

Does REALTOR® University conduct original independent research?

Yes. Our Richard J. Rosenthal Center For Real Estate Studies is a think tank/real estate research laboratory with current, hands-on and results oriented data and analysis relevant to industry trends and policy issues from a practical standpoint. Research is for the REALTOR®, policy makers, legislators, public and industry. The goal is credible, scholarly research of practical use to real estate practitioners.

Do we offer a graduate certificate program?

Yes. There is a graduate certificate program in Real Estate Association Management.

Are we approved to offer on-line programs?

Yes. We have operating and degree granting authority from the Illinois Board of Higher Education.
